

BRITISH COLUMBIA GO ELECTRIC PASSENGER VEHICLE REBATE PROGRAM - VEHICLE ELIGIBILITY APPLICATION FORM

The purpose of this form is to assist the British Columbia Ministry of Energy, Mines and Low Carbon Innovation in assessing whether new zero-emission vehicle models can become eligible for a point-of-purchase rebate under the CleanBC Go Electric Passenger Vehicle Rebate Program. Original Equipment Manufacturers (OEMs) must fill out this form to submit new model year and/or vehicle models for consideration and forward to the email below. General Vehicle Eligibility requirements:

- ☐ Fuel Type must be one of: Battery Electric Vehicle (BEV), Hydrogen Fuel Cell Vehicle (FCEV), or Plug-in Hybrid Electric Vehicle (PHEV) / Electric vehicle with extended range (ER-EV) with a minimum all electric range of 19 KMs
- ☐ Vehicles must have a maximum MSRP¹ under \$55,000 for “Cars”: Two-seater; Mini-compact; Subcompact; Compact; Mid-Size and Full-size; and \$70,000 for “Larger Vehicles”: Station wagon; Pickup truck; Sport utility vehicle; Minivan; Van; Special purpose vehicle. Vehicle Class is as per Natural Resources Canada’s (NRCan) Fuel Consumption Guide
- ☐ Highway capable, CMVSS certified, covered/deemed covered by EPA certificate in accordance with the ORVEER Regulation
- ☐ New, BC registered, OEM vehicle with gross vehicle weight of less than or equal to 3,856 kilograms (8,500 pounds)
- ☐ Any types of conversions are not eligible.

¹MSRP does not include additional costs or fees included in the sale of a vehicle (accessories, dealer fees, environmental fees, pre-delivery inspection fees, etc.).
²Image should be a ¾ view, on transparent background, a portable network graphic (PNG) and 1200px wide at 72dpi or higher. An image in silver or grey is preferred if the vehicle is available in those colours.
³Manufacturer’s invoice and/or window sticker (“Monroney label”), with the MSRP itemization and VIN listed, must be available for each vehicle. Documentation not meeting the criteria may result in delays in processing and/or eligibility reassessment.
